Reading/ELA & Writing: *Superkids* is a comprehensive reading program that includes foundational skills for reading, comprehension, fluency, and writing. Students find the characters and their adventures relatable which increases their engagement and builds their love for reading.

Math: *Progress in Mathematics* provides content focused on building foundational math skills in order to become proficient in math. Each chapter provides opportunities for guided and independent practice, as well as reteaching and enrichment.

Social Studies: Networks' *Who We Are as Americans* focuses on topics such as geography, economics, and the history of America. Each unit introduces students to new vocabulary as well as opportunities to strengthen their reading and writing skills.

Science: *Nancy Larson Science & Mystery Science* are both used as tools to allow for hands-on student exploration in topics such as plants, animals, physics, and geology.
