

Spanish

Grade 5

Students in grade five are novice language learners. They learn to greet one another, address the teacher, and recognize and use vocabulary for the classroom and home. Art, games, literature, and music are incorporated into classwork at all levels.

Grade 6

Sixth grade students continue their exploration of the Spanish language and culture. The students hear and read vocabulary and phrases repeatedly. They begin to recognize capitalization and punctuation conventions in the target language.

Grade 7

In seventh grade, students build onto their base of vocabulary and usage. Holidays and cultural celebrations are explored. Students use numbers for calendar, measurement, and simple math. Students write phrases and sentences for different purposes.

Grade 8

As students become more familiar with the target language, they read and write more in the target language. Topics such as travel and going to a store or restaurant are explored. They have a beginning base of Spanish at the end of grade eight.
